Welcome to 3BC Nursery

The Nursery of Bible Believers Baptist Church is designed to serve infants and toddlers (birth to 36 months), their parents and the church as a whole. By providing loving care for little children, we are helping them form the impression that church is a pleasant place. Because we make provision for little children, parents can attend and participate more fully in the services of the church. In order to achieve our purpose, we ask that you read these guidelines carefully. They have been designed with the welfare of the children in mind. We appreciate your cooperation.

Our nursery is available to children ages birth to 36 months.

The nursery is open

Sunday AM at 10:00 and at 11:00.

Sunday PM at 7:00.

Wednesday PM at 7:00.

Guidelines

1. Please leave your baby at the nursery counter. In order to avoid confusion and to provide proper care and safety for the children, no one is allowed in the nursery at any time except workers, babies and mothers who are nursing their babies. Please do not check on your baby between services. Our caring staff will notify you if we need you.
2. Parents are welcome to look in the door window at any time, but please do not try to come in or get the attention of your child.
3. Please fill out the 3 piece green sticker with all the necessary information. Note any special instructions the workers should follow.
4. Make sure your diaper bag is also tagged with the green bag sticker. In addition, make sure all your child's belongings are marked with his/her name.
5. Equip your diaper bag with the following items: diapers; wipes, enough bottles for the baby's stay in the nursery, extra pull-ups and a complete change of clothes if necessary.
6. This is a well-baby nursery. Please do not bring a sick baby to the nursery. Signs of illness include unusual fatigue or irritability, coughing, sneezing, runny nose (thick green or yellow mucus), fever, questionable rash, vomiting or diarrhea within the past 24 hours, infected eyes, open sores.
7. Leave the nursery area quickly after the preliminaries are completed so your baby can adjust to his new surroundings. If crying persists a nursery worker will page you.
8. When the service is over, return for your baby as soon as possible
9. Your baby will be returned only to you. Do not send a sibling, relative or friend. For the good of all concerned, this rule is strictly enforced.
